- 2.Each mare and her foal will be judged as a unit 60% for the Broodmare and 40% for the foal.
- 3.A Maximum of 2 exhibits may qualify, provided the judges feel the standard is high enough for the ISA Championship.
- 4.The mare's passport will be inspected at 12 noon before judging commences. Final to commence at 1pm sharp. Exhibitors failing to produce a passport will be debarred from competing.
- 5.Qualified mares may not compete in other classes at the Iverk Show.
- 6.Foals are eligible to compete in the foal classes at the Iverk Show.
- 7.Foals must be led at all times.

3. No bits. No mechanical hackamores. No bridles relying primarily on poll pressure. No Spurs.
4. Permitted equipment includes side pulls, bosals, rope halters, & mecates.
5. No draw reins, standing martingales, tie-downs, or auxiliary devices that restrict the horse's natural head and neck position

Judging Priorities: Relaxation and confidence. Sound, free, and regular movement. Partnership and sympathetic horsemanship. Correct self-carriage, with the horse travelling comfortably in front of or at the vertical. Good conformation and condition. Lightness and willingness. Manners and safety. Poll should be higher than withers.

The judge will penalise: Obvious tension or conflict behaviours.

4. Test the cake by lightly pressing the centre. it should spring back and the top should be golden brown, insert a skewer. If it comes out clean, the cake is cooked.
5. Leave in the tin for 5 mins and then turn out onto a cool wire tray

Preheat oven to 350F/180C/Gas Mark 4, Lightly Grease a 2lb Loaf Tin and line with Parchment

Method

1. Measure all the ingredients into a mixing bowl and beat for 2 minutes until well blended, an electric mixer is best for this but of course you can also beat by hand.
2. Spoon the mixture into the prepared tin and level surface
3. Bake for about an hour until well risen and golden brown, a fine skewer inserted in the center of cake should come out clean.
4. Leave cake to cool and turn out, remove lining paper and leave to cool on the tray.

All-In-One-Method:

1. Brush the tin with melted margarine or butter & place a strip or a circle of greaseproof paper on the bottom
2. Place all the ingredients together in a mixing bowl & beat with a wooden spoon until well mixed (2-3 minutes)
3. Place the mixture in the prepared tin & smooth the top
4. Arrange the walnut halves or whole almonds & cherry halved on the top.
5. Bake in the pre-heated oven on the middle shelf for 1 ½ - 1 ¾ hours.
6. Test (see below) & remove from the oven when baked.
7. Leave in the tin for 10 minutes, then turn out, remove the paper & cool on a wire tray. Store in an airtight container.

To Test Harvest Fruit Loaf: Press the top of the Cake lightly with the fingers - it should feel firm. Thrust a clean, warm skewer into the middle of the cake, if it comes out clean, with no uncooked mixture clinging to it, the cake is ready.
